Congratulations! You are a graduating senior this year, and your science research project entered in the 56th State Science and Engineering Fair of Florida (SSEF), entitles you to apply to be **nominated** for a Scholarship or one of our Opportunity Awards. All of this year's offerings will be listed and described on the website as they are confirmed.

On our website you will find a **Scholarship Nomination Application Form** for the Scholarship Nominations to be awarded at the SSEF this year. You must complete a separate application for each scholarship you are interested in pursuing. There must be an **original Transcript with an official seal** for at least one of your applications.

You will also find applications to apply for the **NASA Summer Internship** or the **National Youth Science Camp**. These are considered opportunity awards and an individual interview will take place on Judging Day, March 24th.

Applications must be complete when you turn them in March 23rd at the Scholarship/Opportunity Awards Table during registration and project set-up. Make sure you meet the requirements for teacher nomination letters and signatures. All applications are due by 5:00 PM. Please note that there will not be a FAX available on site to get any missing information sent to you.

A word of caution! If you plan to apply for these scholarships and internships, see your guidance counselor AS SOON AS POSSIBLE for your transcript! Do not wait until the day you leave for SSEF.
